
If user encounters the following message

"There is a problem with this website's security certificate" while trying to access the website in Internet Explorer, follow the steps given below:

Guidelines: To add a website to a security zone:

- 1. Open Internet Explorer by clicking the Start button (2). In the search box, type Internet Explorer, and then, in the list of results, click Internet Explorer.
- 2. Navigate to the website that you want to add to a specific security zone.
- 3. Click the Tools button, and then click Internet Options.



- 4. Click the Security tab, and then click a security zone (Trusted sites).
- 5. Click Sites.
- 6. If you clicked Local intranet in step 4, click Advanced.
- 7. The website should be shown in the Add this website to the zone field. Click Add.
- 8. If the site is not a secure site (HTTPS), clear the Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone check box.
- 9. Click Close, and then click OK (or click OK twice if you clicked Local intranet in step 4).
